### OFFICE UPDATE & INFORMATION

First Fruits: Poke Run Church has committed to giving \$3,125 to Redstone Presbytery for the "Mission of the Larger Church." This comes to about \$27.50 per member. To date, the congregation has given specifically to this in the amount of 40% of the pledge. The Budget & Finance Committee hopes that you will consider giving to First Fruits to close the gap on the remaining balance of our pledge.
