1985 Poke Run Presbyterian Church Cookbook from the kitchen of Miriam Smith

"Cabbage Coleslaw"

1 med. Head of cabbage, 1 mango or green pepper

(grated) (chopped)

1 carrot (grated) 1 tsp. salt

Sauce:

1 c. vinegar 1 1/2 c. sugar

1/4 c. water 1 tsp. celery seed

Add teaspoon salt to grated cabbage and let stand for 1 hour. Then squeeze all juice out. Add the carrots and mango or green pepper to cabbage. Mix and boil sauce for 1 minute. Let stand until its only warm. Pour over cabbage mixture. Ready to eat. Store in refrigerator or freezer.
